- 1 O God, you are my God; <u>earnestly</u> I seek you; my soul <u>thirsts</u> for you; my flesh <u>faints</u> for you,
 - as in a dry and weary land where there is no water.
- 2 So I have looked upon you in the <u>sanctuary</u>, beholding your <u>power</u> and <u>glory</u>.
- 3 Because your <u>steadfast</u> love is better than life, my lips will <u>praise</u> you.
- 4 So I will <u>bless</u> you as long as I live; in your <u>name</u> I will lift up my hands.
- 5 My soul will be <u>satisfied</u> as with fat and rich food, and my mouth will praise you with <u>joyful</u> lips,
- 6 when I <u>remember</u> you upon my bed, and <u>meditate</u> on you in the watches of the night;
- 7 for you have been my <u>help</u>,
 and in the shadow of your <u>wings</u> I will sing for joy.
- 8 My soul <u>clings</u> to you; your right hand <u>upholds</u> me.
- 9 But those who seek to destroy my life shall go down into the depths of the earth;
- 10 they shall be given over to the power of the sword; they shall be a portion for jackals.
- 11 But the king shall <u>rejoice</u> in God;
 all who swear by him shall <u>exult</u>,
 for the mouths of liars will be stopped.
